

**CITY OF BEATTYVILLE/BEATTYVILLE WATERWORKS
CONTRACT FOR WATER SERVICE**

THIS CONTRACT made and entered into this _____ day of _____,
between _____ whose address is _____,
_____, Kentucky, party of the first part, and the City
of Beattyville Waterworks, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH THAT for and in consideration of the efforts of the party of the second part, acting through the Mayor/City Council Members, the party of the first part agrees to pay a Water Connection fee of \$1,700.00 at the time of signing this contract to connect to the water system and to pay at least the minimum monthly bill thereafter regardless of whether the party of the first part connects to the system.

The party of the first part agrees to permit the city to maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on the property to be designated by the city for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property.

The party of the first part agrees that no other present or future source of water will be connected to any water lines served by the city's water lines.

The party of the first part also agrees that any tampering or damage to the meter by the first party will be responsible for all parts and labor to repair the meter.

The party of the first part shall maintain at his/her own expense any repairs to the service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or the place of use.

The party of the second part shall determine the allocation of water to the party of the first part in the event of a water shortage and may disconnect the party of the first part if he/she allows a connection or extension to be made of his/her service line for the purpose of supplying water to another party.

The party of the first part agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, by laws, rules, and regulations of the city now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended, or changed.

The Utility expressly reserves the right to disconnect, confiscate unauthorized devices, and/or discontinue service or any other connection with or without notice where the Utility discovers, finds or is otherwise made aware of any such installation that poses a threat to the supply, public health or public safety.

The utility cannot guarantee uninterrupted service and will not be responsible for any claims arising out of the failure to deliver continuous service.

If the party of the second part fails to make available water service to the party of the first part, the \$1,700.00 tap-on fee shall be refunded in full.
