- Step 1. Advertise your intent to apply for a local and state Alcoholic Beverage Control license in the local newspaper.
- Step 2. Complete the online State application from the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control at <a href="https://abc-portal.ky.gov/s/">www.abc.ky.gov</a> or <a href="https://abc-portal.ky.gov/s/">https://abc-portal.ky.gov/s/</a> or by contacting their offices at 502.564.4850. Paper applications are no longer accepted by the State ABC. You must show proof that your state application has been filed when submitting your City of Beattyville license application.
- Step 3. Apply for a City Occupational License (for new businesses or if you're an existing business and haven't done so already) by contacting the City Clerk at City Hall at 28 Railroad Street Beattyville, KY.
- Step 4. Complete the City of Beattyville Alcoholic Beverage Control Application (applications may be picked up at City Hall, 28 Railroad Street, Beattyville, KY). Receive a copy of the City of Beattyville Alcoholic Beverage Control ordinance. Return the completed City of Beattyville application to City Hall and Include payment.

Step 5. A City License will be issued when a copy of your State License is provided to the Beattyville A.B.C. Administrator, Cody Sparks Police Chief.
